FROM OUR PASTOR

One of the challenges that we sometimes have in church is understanding how best to communicate our church "words" so that people who don't understand our insider lingo can know what we are talking about. I remember hearing a preaching professor challenge us to use words that help the gospel touch our skin. That's why I love one of the phrases that we use all the time, "being the hands of Christ". To me, that is as simple and as obvious as it gets.

In just a few days, we will have our Hands of Christ emphasis on Saturday, April 6. In recent years, that day has looked like specific short-term mission projects in and around Rome and Floyd County, and we have always had a huge crowd that participates in this day. This year will be a little different. We will have an opportunity to participate in the Bridges out of Poverty training that is the next step in the conversation that Ruby Payne catalyzed a few months ago. Why would this kind of a day be synonymous with being the "Hands of Christ"?

When Jesus encountered people throughout the gospels, he did several things before he actually performed his miracles. He listened. He asked questions. He dialogued with whatever man, woman, or child was in need, and then he offered the best possible help that he could offer that would meet their deepest need. Our time together in the "Bridges out of Poverty" training will help us to be able to respond in ways that mirror Jesus' approach—to listen, to dialogue, and then to discern how to offer our best help that meets a great need. As we strive to be the Hands of Christ, we want to do our very best to emulate the ways of Christ, and we think this will get us closer to that striving! I look forward to seeing you there!

THE GIFT OF SCULPTURE

Several years ago, Frank Murphy completed, *Pieta*', a marble sculpture he created based on Michelangelo's *Pieta*' at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, Italy. Frank's sculpture captivated our hearts as it remained in the Sanctuary during the season of Lent that year. Earlier this year, a very generous donor purchased Frank Murphy's *Pieta*' as a gift to the church. The Properties Committee and Brooks Construction carefully managed the installation in our Memorial Garden. Final touches will make it ready for Holy Week. Frank offers Isaiah 53:5 as a focus for this work:

"He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed."
