As our Discovery team sorted through conversations and the information gathered from listening sessions, one of the things that we heard clearly was that the people of FBC Rome wanted to continue to be leaders in Christian mission and service as we followed Christ's call in our community and beyond. In response to that clear desire, members of our serve team and ministerial staff have been seeking to understand what that looks like as our church moves into the third decade of this millennium.

What will this look like? Well, we want to take the things that we do really well and continue to do them, AND we want to do those things even more effectively. We want to help people who are in crisis AND we also want to do more developmental ministry with our brothers and sisters so that they don't stay in crisis.
