Several creative and meaningful worship experiences await our church family as we approach the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is February 17 and marks the first day of this holy season of reflection and introspection.

On this day you can participate in an interactive, self-guided, comeand-go experience in the Sanctuary from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. Several stations will be set up around the room where you will be directed to think about how you can prepare for Lent. The entire experience should take 20-30 minutes.

The stations are tactile and will be COVID and family-friendly. If you have been longing to spend some time in the Sanctuary, but have not felt that Sunday morning was the best time to do that, this is your opportunity. To ensure safety, please reserve a time to participate by going to a link on the home page of the church website or you may call Karen Garrett in the office. Participants will come through at 10-15 minute increments. I hope that those who do not work during the day can come earlier so that families who have working parents can use the time slots later in the afternoon and early evening.

It would be perfect for those working downtown to take part during your lunch hour. Regular precautions (temperature checks, masks, etc.) will be observed.

Our Sunday worship theme for Lent is "Holy Vessels." Each week we will explore ways that Jesus offered healing in the Bible and still offers healing to us today. Tamara, John and Kristen will rotate preaching duties. More information on these services is inside this edition of the Spire.

Finally, we will celebrate Baptistism and Communion in worship on February 14. For those of you worshiping at home, be sure to have your bread and cup ready to participate.
