

A MESSAGE FROM JOHN ULDRICK

The story of the transfiguration in Mark is one of the clearest examples from Scripture that Jesus wants to be seen and heard. In fact, the very words from God are, "This is my son, my beloved, listen to him." The fact that Jesus is revealed, by himself, in dazzling white and glowing like only the Son of God can, is a testimony in itself. Our challenge then is to realize and remember who Jesus is for each of us and to LISTEN TO HIM!

One of the many ways in which the membership of First Baptist Church has seen and listened to Christ is through our longstanding relationship with Habitat for Humanity. Habitat is one of the local partners we support with our hands, our hearts, and our financial resources. The relationship is both deep and broad. Together, we are providing shelter for those in our community who need it most.

In late May of 2020, Bob Hortman encouraged us to begin the process of building the Habitat house that had originally been

scheduled to begin just before the COVID pandemic. He promised his guidance and leadership, and boy, did he come through! The house on Branham Avenue has risen from the ground thanks to Bob Hortman's organizational and volunteer recruitment skills, Jeff Brooks' expertise in building exceptional homes, and the countless other volunteers who used their own two hands and gave of their time. Relationships have been cultivated with the Marks family, led by the efforts of Diane Wilson, who has served well as the family liaison. In total, 65 volunteers logged 1,525 hours of work on this project.

I believe the house at Branham Avenue will stand as testimony to the ways in which First Baptist continues to SEE and LISTEN to the Spirit of God, alive in Rome and Floyd County!

ORGAN RENOVATION

A plan was approved last year to expose around 450 of our nearly 4,000 organ pipes on either side of the bare walls by the baptistery. The Finance Committee has approved the expenditure and we have had enough generous donations to bring this project to fruition. The work will begin soon after Easter and will take about six weeks to complete. The organ will still be available for use on Sundays. Joan Hill has worked closely with the organ builder



to carefully select which pipes we will use and to be sure that it not only sounds great, but that it is aesthetically pleasing, as well. An artist's rendering of what it should look like is pictured. Each week we enjoy hearing the largest pipe organ in north Georgia. I believe it will enhance our worship and the beauty of the Sanctuary when this project is completed. Please contact Keith with any questions.
