
## CHILDREN'S CORNER

#### PEW SIGNS TAKE THE GUESS WORK OUT OF SPACING

As many are returning to Worship Services in person in the Sanctuary, you may notice the signs in the pews. These signs mark a perfect six feet of distancing between family units (whether a family of one or many. Under this system, when you find your seat, slide the guide down the pew. This will indicate what space remains for the next family unit. Large families are asked to sit on one pew and place the guide on the empty pew behind them. Seating will now be on every other row. This makes finding a seat for worship even easier—especially as we have increased our seating capacity.

#### MEDICAL DEBT CAMPAIGN

First Baptist Church of Rome plans to join together with First Baptist Church of Dalton, Heritage Baptist Church, First Baptist Church of Marietta in a medical debt campaign. RIP Medical Debt (https://ripmedicaldebt.org) will help us locate medical debt in each of our counties and in the state of Georgia that is available to be eliminated with our financial help. The debt that RIP has access to is on the secondary market, which means it is at least two years old.

Every \$1 raised can wipe out approximately \$100 of medical debt. The churches listed above will work together to raise \$50,000 to wipe out \$5 million of accessible debt in our counties and in Georgia.
