FROM OUR INTERIM PASTOR

All of us need to keep growing in our knowledge of God's Word and its relevance for our lives. There are many approaches to assist us in that process, and one which I would like to recommend to you is called, "Lectio Divina" (Divine Reading). Christians since the 3rd century have experienced meaningful spiritual growth as they have used this discipline.

The five steps of Lectio Divina are:

- 1. Lectio (Read) Read the chosen biblical text slowly and prayerfully, and perhaps re-read it as you truly listen to God speak to you through His Word.
- 2. Meditatio (Meditate) Ponder the Word of God in your heart, reflecting on what it means to you. Memorize one or more of the verses, allowing them to interact with your thoughts, hopes, and desires.
- 3. Oratio (Pray) Prayer is your response to God's Word, as you dialogue with God about what He is saying to you. Enjoy a loving conversation with Him as you speak your prayer and as you listen to Him.

- 4. Contemplatio (Contemplate) Rest in God's presence and receive His transforming embrace. At this point, your words are not necessary. Be content and at peace with a quiet rest in God.
- 5. Actio (Act) Through the scripture which you have read and meditated upon, decide upon a concrete, specific act which you could do as you apply God's Word in a relevant way, serving someone in Jesus' name.

As you experience the Lectio Divina process, use any biblical passage such as Matthew 5:1-12, or Philippians 4:4-9. Set aside 20 or 30 minutes and enjoy growing in your faith. You can learn much more about this method through an internet search of "Lectio Divina".


