#### COVID GUIDELINES FOR WORSHIP AT FBC

The Centers for Disease Control has issued recommendations that apply to non-health care settings. The recommendation that specifically applies to worship and other meetings at First Baptist Church of Rome says that fully vaccinated people can now resume activities without wearing masks or physically distancing. The following guidelines, as recommended by the CDC, are in place for worship and other gatherings at First Baptist Church of Rome:

- 1. Masks are not required for those who are fully vaccinated. Masks should be worn by those who are not fully vaccinated.
- 2. Following CDC guidelines, children and youth who are not fully vaccinated will continue to be required to wear masks.
- 3. Seating will still be on every other pew. Fully vaccinated individuals are no longer required to maintain social distance from each other.
