### **Call to Worship (read in unison)**

### **Sentences of Scripture (read these scriptures aloud)**

Jesus invites us: Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart and you will find rest for your souls. —Matthew 11:28-29

Jesus declares: I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty. Everything that the Father gives me will come to me and anyone who comes to me, I will never drive away. —John 6:35, 37

### **Invitation to the Lord's Supper**

We invite you now to spiritually unite with all the members of First Baptist Church of Rome and partake of the Lord's Supper. According to Luke, when our risen

Lord was at table with his disciples, he took bread and blessed it and broke it and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him.

### **Sharing the Bread**

The bread may now be taken with these words:

### **Sharing the Cup**

The cup may now be taken with these words:  
“In the same way, He took the cup and said, ‘This cup is the new covenant sealed by my blood. Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me.’”

### **Time of Prayer**

Each participant may offer a brief sentence prayer.

After a time for silent prayer offer this closing prayer in unison:

We thank you, O God, that You have given us Your Son, who is the true bread from heaven and food of eternal life. We lift up to You, this day, these joys and concerns of our hearts: So strengthen us that our daily living may show our thanks, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
