## FROM OUR INTERIM PASTOR

#### YOUR LENTEN JOURNEY

Beginning with Ash Wednesday, March 2, we have been experiencing the journey of Lent, the period of 40 days leading up to Easter, April 17. During Lent, the focus for Christians is upon reflection and repentance. The discipline of reflection requires that we simplify our calendars and create spaces in our daily lives so that we can experience God in fresh ways. In Psalm 46:10, God calls us to "be still and know that I am God." Find time each day to be still so that you can know Him in a deeper, more personal way.

A second purpose of Lent is repentance, which is a turning away from our sins and a turning toward God and His purpose for our lives. Jesus said, "Repent, for the kingdom of Heaven has come near." (Matthew 4:17) And, in Acts 3:19, God says to us, "Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord."

All of us have sinned, and we all need to repent of those sins. In his wonderful little book, *Wishful Thinking*, Frederick Buechner describes sin in this way: "The power of sin is centrifugal. When at work in a human life, it tends to push everything out toward the periphery. Bits and pieces go flying off until only the core is left. Eventually bits and pieces of the core itself go flying off until in the end nothing at all is left. Sin is whatever you do, or fail to do, that pushes people and God away, that widens the gap between you and them, and also the gaps within your self."

I hope that you will find meaningful ways in your Lenten journey to reflect and to repent as you follow Jesus on His way to the cross. In Him,
