FROM OUR PASTOR

"The journey is half the fun," we often say, or "Enjoyment is in the journey, not the destination." Tell that to children on December 1. See how they react. My guess is that you will get some big "eye rolls" and groans! When we are children, the time between Thanksgiving and December 25th seems like a year, and every day seems like a week. Can't we just fast forward to Christmas morning? The anticipation is agonizing and our patience is at its thinnest point of the year. Over time, though, we can learn the joys of anticipation, patience, and waiting that are characteristic of the season of Advent.

Like many Baptists, I did not grow up observing Advent. But ever since I was introduced to the season of Advent in my early twenties, I have approached Christmas differently. I am more intentional to focus on hope, peace, joy, and love as each week passes. I have learned to be more patient. I have prayed more often, "Lord, let your kingdom come on earth, as it is in heaven." In short, Advent has become for me a very meaningful and fulfilling time of anticipation. Now that I am beyond the age of 50, I pray for time to slow down!

How about you? Would you like to fast forward to Christmas right now? Or perhaps you'd like to skip over Christmas completely because it is too stressful, too hyped, or even too painful. Wherever you find yourself today in your attitude about the coming of Christmas, let the Advent journey guide you. Walk slowly through each day; pray often; serve someone; listen intentionally for messages of God's hope, peace, joy, and love. And trust once more that in the waiting and in the walking of the Advent journey, God is with you.
