FROM OUR PASTOR

One time, in her role as the British prime minister, Margaret Thatcher was visiting a nursing home, going from room to room and meeting senior adults. One of the residents showed no sign of realizing that she was shaking hands with a very famous world leader. "Do you know who I am?" asked Mrs. Thatcher. "No, dear," replied the elderly woman, "but I should ask the nurse if I were you. She usually knows."

When a loved one or friend deals with memory loss, we can be there to patiently remind them of who they are and how they are loved by us. But they are not the only ones who need to be reminded of their identity. Everyone can benefit from intentionally asking ourselves, Who am I? What defines me as a person? What makes me who I am? And Holy Week, which begins on Palm Sunday, is a good time to ponder these deep questions. Yes, we learn about Jesus during Holy Week, but we are also challenged to learn more about who we are in him.

If you want a good starting point to answer the question of your own identity, here it is: "I have been crucified with Christ," the Apostle Paul wrote, "and it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me" (Galatians 2:19-20). Is this a true statement about who you are? If not, take time this Holy Week to pray, to search within, to worship God, to give thanks for what Jesus did as he gave his life for you. Let your life be crucified with Christ. Then, when Easter arrives, let your life be renewed and resurrected so that Jesus can truly come alive and live through you.
