FROM OUR PASTOR

We all know that nobody is perfect. No one gets it right all the time—whatever "it" may be. But that does not stop our obsession with perfectionism. I'm not saying that perfectionism is a burden that all of us bear, but I'm guessing that there are quite of a few of us who wrestle with it. We want things to be just right. We want to control the outcome. We want to know before we start something that the end result will be exactly how we envision it in our minds. But the end result of our perfectionism and our need for control is crippling. It leads to chronic procrastination because we know that nothing can go wrong if we don't actually begin to do something. Or, when things do not go precisely as we had hoped, we beat ourselves up with self-condemnation.

This year, our guiding question as a congregation is, "Where is Jesus?" If perfectionism is your struggle, then the answer to this question is what Paul heard from Jesus: "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Cor. 12:9). Jesus cannot

be present in our lives if our goal is perfection. After all, what need do we have for Jesus if we are always right, always strong, always perfect? We discover Jesus afresh and anew whenever we accept our weaknesses and rely upon the grace of God to guide us. Because God does not expect perfection. Instead, God desires our trust and our willingness to simply walk with him, no matter what.

So go ahead. Take a risk at not getting something right. If you fail, it won't be the first time and you won't be alone. God's grace will be there to support you. And who knows how you might find Jesus in new and unexpected ways because you are choosing to rely not on your own abilities or strengths, but on his power that is made perfect in your weakness.
