



# FROM OUR PASTOR

#### GOOD MORNING

Some of us are morning persons, while others are definitely not morning persons. As the old joke goes, when the alarm clock sounds, morning persons say, "Good morning, Lord," while others say, "Good Lord, it's morning!" But if we are followers of the risen Lord Jesus, then—in a sense—we are all morning persons, because Easter happened in the morning. At least that's when the empty tomb was discovered by the women: "as the first day of the week was dawning" (Mt. 28:1). They could have waited a few hours until the sun had come up. They could have gone in the afternoon or the evening of that first day of the week. Instead, they chose to go in the morning. They couldn't wait any longer.

This Sunday morning, we will gather for worship like we do every Sunday. The sanctuary may be a little fuller and our outfits a little brighter. The sweet smells of lilies will be in the air and the ringing of

bells will remind us of the holiness and happiness of Easter morn. But truth be told, every morning of our lives is a mini-Easter. Every morning is cause for celebration. Every morning is reason to pray, "This is the day which the Lord has made; I will rejoice and be glad in it" (Psalm 118:24).

Some of us may, indeed, shout for joy as soon our feet hit the floor in the morning, while others of us require an hour or so, plus a few cups of coffee, to get to the rejoicing. But for all of us, the rising sun of every morning reminds us that the Son has risen. While there may be only one Good Friday, because of Easter, every morning can be for us a good morning.

This Easter morning, and every morning, let us rejoice and proclaim: Christ is risen from the dead! Hallelujah!
