Within one chapter of Matthew's Gospel, we will explore six different parables. Led by Pastor David Brooks.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Do you remember the story of Moses and the burning bush in Exodus 3? Moses had fled for his life from Egypt and was keeping a herd of sheep. At Horeb, Moses saw an incredible sight: an angel of the Lord that appeared to him in a flame of fire out of a bush. But the bush was not consumed by the fire. I'm sure fire was not an unusual

to Moses. He could have walked right on by and been on his way. Instead, he said to himself, "I must turn aside and look at this great sight, and see why the bush is not burned up" (Ex. 3:3). It was only when God saw that Moses had turned his attention toward the burning bush that God actually spoke up and communicated with Moses.

Fast forward to our lives today. If the story of the burning bush teaches us anything, it is this: if we want to hear God speak or see God among us, then perhaps God is waiting for us to take the first step by paying closer attention to the people and events around us. I believe that there are "burning bushes" all around us every day, but we pass them by and do not recognize the presence of God in them because we are not intentional to "turn aside" and look, listen, and search for God.

Look closely. Listen intentionally. Turn aside more often to notice the burning bushes of God's presence in our world. Then, help someone else to see the fire, as well. Help others to turn aside from the busyness and demands of life so that they, too, can recognize the burning bushes that are ablaze all around us. Who knows how our lives might change? Who knows what God will reveal to us and how God will call us to serve? It all starts when we choose to turn aside and ask God to make himself known to us each day.
