Several years ago, the Adult Faith Formations Committee began offering a program called, "FaithTalks" with the tagline, Faith inForming Life. These talks, initially patterned after TEDtalks and held each 5th Sunday during Bible Study, invite individuals to tell their life's story and how their faith informs the way they live and the witness they offer in the world.

Please join us on Sunday, December 31, for a very special Faith-Talks, as we welcome Stacie Marshall, Melvin and Betty Mosley, as well as members of the New Harmony Baptist Church congregation.

Their story has become a focus of a new documentary film, *Her Name Was Hester*. The film details Stacie's recent inheritance of her family's farm in Chattooga County, Georgia and uncovering family records that included an enslaved wet nurse named Hester. Almost 150 years after her passing, descendants of Hester lived as neighbors and friends. They prayed, worshipped, and shared meals together not knowing of their shared history. One of our own FBC Rome members, Virginia Bolton, discovered a beautiful overlapping history.

#### MISSION TRIP OPPORTUNITY TO IMMOKALEE, FL

This missions committee is offering a chance to work with CBF field personnel, Rick & Ellen Burnette, in Immokalee, FL, March 5-9, 2024. The Burnettes founded Cultivate Abundance in 2017 which is a growing faith-based organization addressing food insecurity and other livelihood challenges in low-income, migrant farmworker communities of Southwest Florida and beyond. We will be joining in their efforts and we hope you will consider being a part of it! Mission work will include helping to complete a project at a local church that will benefit the area when aid workers are needed in natural disasters; helping with the weekly distribution of food to migrant workers; and brain-storming with Rick and Ellen about ways FBC Rome can partner with Cultivate Abundance in the future. This opportunity is open to any church member and construction skills are not required to be helpful.
