The season of Lent starts early this year—February 14. So, it's not too soon to be thinking about how you plan to walk with Jesus more closely as a Lenten discipline. We will begin Lent a little differently this year:

Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper - February 13

- In the fellowship hall
- Mardi Gras themed

Interactive Ash Wednesday Service – February 14

- Come at any time between Noon and 5:00 p.m.
- Several stations in the sanctuary will prepare you for Lent and introduce you to our Lenten worship series, "Wandering Heart."
- New labyrinth to walk in our activity center.



FROM OUR PASTOR

Easter comes early this year—Sunday, March 31. And that means the season of Lent starts earlier than usual. In fact, Lent is right here upon us, with Ash Wednesday falling on Valentine's Day, February 14. That's an odd combination, don't you think? Ash Wednesday calls for restraint and repentance, while Valentine's Day calls for lavish expressions of love and affection. But maybe there's something these two days have in common: a call to love more deeply, whether that is love for God, love for our neighbor, or a healthier love of ourselves. This unique confluence of days can also be a deep reminder of God's love for us through Jesus.

As we begin Lent, let's back it up a day this year and begin on *Shrove Tuesday*, February 13, with supper in our Fellowship Hall, from 5:00-6:30 pm. After supper, we'll enjoy some fun activities, learn about the meaning of Shrove Tuesday, and finish with King Cake for dessert.

Then, on Ash Wednesday, come to the sanctuary anytime between 12:00 noon and 6:00 pm for a self-guided interactive experience of various "stations" to begin your Lenten journey to the cross. Our new prayer labyrinth will also be set up in the gym so that you can walk, pray, meditate, and draw closer to Jesus.

As we walk with Jesus in Lent this year, our theme will be **Wandering Heart: Figuring Out Faith with Peter**. Each week, we will consider a significant moment in Peter's journey—from becoming a disciple to meeting the risen Jesus. Along the way, we're likely to see both our flawed and our faithful selves in Peter. And as we learn about faith through Peter, we will draw closer to Jesus who calls us to follow him.
